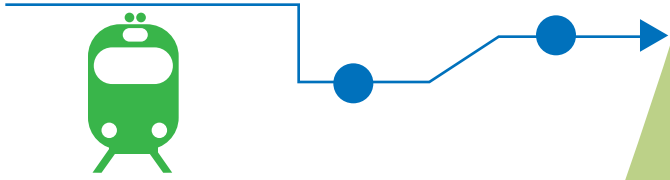


GO EAST CLARINGTON Transportation Hubs
