

CONDITIONS

Eligibility for involvement in “Trees for Rural Roads” may be limited by overhead or underground utilities, site lines, drainage, or suitability of planting site. Spacing and location will depend upon suitability of site for species requested, such as soil and drainage, location of existing trees on the property, etc.

Every effort will be made to inform the landowner in how they can increase the chances of survival and tree growth. It is understood that the survival of individual trees cannot be, and is not, guaranteed. The applicant agrees to plant the trees adjacent to the road right-of-way. Planting instructions will be provided. It is the responsibility of the landowner to ensure trees being planted do not in any way interfere with above and below ground utilities. The Trees for Rural Roads Program does not take any responsibility in the long-term care and maintenance of the trees planted under this program.
