HISTORY:

The Newcastle Village Community Hall was constructed by Chester Daniel Massey and completed prior to July 30, 1923. On a later date, Mr. Massey and the Village of Newcastle executed an agreement in which Mr. Massey transferred the title of the building to the Newcastle Village. The Newcastle Village Community Hall Board was first established in 1959 as a Community Centre Board, under the Community Centres Act 1949, by By-law No. 723. In 1983 as a result of monies bequeathed by a citizen to the Municipality, a sum of \$10,000 was invested in a trust fund and the annual interest was directed to be the income for the Newcastle Village Community Hall.
