Inclusion Services

All children are welcome at our summer camp programs. Call our Camp Hotline: 905-435-1061 ext. 2565 upon registration if you require support or accommodation for your children due to a special need.

Extra support at camp is generally required according to the following criteria:

- a physical, developmental and/or learning disability exists, affecting mobility, communication, comprehension and/or interaction.
- extra support/assistance is required at home for basic care such as dressing or toileting.
- extra support is required at school.

Please ensure that if your child requires additional staff support, you call the Camp Hotline prior to registering and speak with our Inclusion Supervisor. This will enable your child to have a positive and supported time at camp.

To facilitate a successful experience for your child, parents will be required to complete a camper skills checklist prior to the start of camp. **Program available to Clarington residents only.**

*Families not disclosing the needs of a participant prior to registration may be required to withdraw from the program. The Municipality of Clarington refund policy will apply.



Government-issued identification is **required every time** you pick-up your child from camp.

Summer Kickoff & Wind Down

Early Bird Camp | Ages 6 to 12

Summer Send-Off Camp | Ages 6 to 12 years

If you don't want the summer to come to an end so soon, join us for one more week of fun and games. Participants will take part in games, crafts, special events and much more! Participants will have the opportunity to swim every day (weather permitting). In the event of severe weather, campers will be bused to Diane Hamre Recreation Complex and then return to Orono Park for pick up at end of day. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

Arts & Culinary Camps

Arts Camp | Ages 6 to 12

A camp for the creative kids in your house. Our staff will lead campers through exciting themed crafts, dance, and music and improvisation activities each week. Campers will have the opportunity to share their talents and learn new skills. Activities may include painting, singing songs, making music, dancing and acting. Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during each session. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

Dance Camp | Ages 6 to 12

Have a blast dancing your heart out at this nontechnical, high energy dance camp. Campers get creative as they put together routines in many different styles of dance led by our supportive and talented instructors. Focus is on fun - no previous dance experience required. Participants will have the opportunity to swim once during the camp week. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

Jr. Chef Camp | Ages 6 to 12

Children will enjoy cooking and eating a variety of fun recipes all while learning basic cooking skills and kitchen safety. Exciting activities, games, crafts and creations will center around fun in the kitchen. Morning and afternoon snacks will be created by campers each day. Due to the nature of this camp, we will not be able to accommodate all dietary restrictions/concerns. Please see your Camp Supervisor for a weekly menu on day 1. Please ensure to send your camper with lunch and lots of water. Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during each session.

Music Camp | Ages 6 to 12

You can't stop the beat. Our staff will lead campers through fun and exciting musical activities which may include musical instrument crafts, sing-a-longs, learning dance moves and special musical guests. Focus is on fun - no previous music experience required. Participants will have the opportunity to swim once each session.

Theatre Stars Camp | Ages 7 to 12

Lights, Camera, Action. Explore the world of theatre in a supportive and interactive environment. We will work on learning aspects of performance and theatre production with rehearsing and preparing for our Finale Friday. No agents or casting calls necessary, just a lot of fun! Participants will have the opportunity to swim once during the session.

Sports Camps

Basketball Camp | Ages 7 to 12

If your child is looking for a fun, energy filled week, this new camp is sure to be a slam dunk. Participants of various skill levels will have the opportunity to learn the rules of the game and work on dribbling, passing and shooting skills, in combination with other traditional camp activities, crafts and games. Emphasis is on sportsmanship, fun and love of the game. Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during each session. *Free busing to and from camp is available.



Dodgeball Camp | Ages 7 to 12

Dodge, dive, dip, duck and defend at this high energy, active camp where you're guaranteed to have a ton of fun while polishing up your dodgeball skills. Campers work on throwing, catching, dodging, court movement and positioning, as well as offensive and defensive strategies to use in a wide variety of different styles of game play. Emphasis will be on fun as campers play old favourites, like Kings Court, and are introduced to new styles like Money Ball, Survivor, Dr. Dodgeball and more. Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during each session. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

Hockey Camp | Ages 6 to 10

This camp offers players (both boys and girls) of various skill levels the experience of a house league hockey camp atmosphere with a combination of traditional off-ice camp activities. On ice sessions will be hourly with up to two hours guaranteed per day. A variety of off-ice activities may include swimming, sports and other games. Participants must provide their own snacks and drinks, as well as lunches. **Full ice hockey equipment is required, including CSA approved hockey helmet.** Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during each session.

Nerf Mania Camp | Ages 6 to 12

Calling all Nerf fanatics. This active camp will allow participants to engage with other Nerf fans in games, activities and challenges. Participants must bring their own Nerf Launcher and mandatory eye protection, please label your campers' personal items with their initials or first and last name. Nerf darts will be provided, please do not bring darts from home. Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during the session. *Free busing to and from camp is available.



Road Hockey Camp | Ages 7 to 12

An active, energy filled week of road hockey fun. Play every variety of road hockey under the sun from straight up ball hockey, to scooter board shinny and mini stick mania. Combined with traditional camp activities, hockey themed crafts and games, this camp is sure to please every hockey fan. No experience necessary. **CSA approved helmet with full face cage/shield and hockey gloves are required.** Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during each session. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

Soccer Camp | Ages 7 to 12

Attention soccer fans - we've got a camp for you. From first time footballers to world cup hopefuls, this camp is for all skill levels. Learn and improve your soccer ability through fun drills and skills with an emphasis on sportsmanship and love of the game. Participants will have the opportunity to participate in traditional camp games and swim once during each session. *Free busing to and from camp is available.



Sports of All Sorts Camp | Ages 7 to 12

A smörgåsbord of sports for campers wanting a more active camp experience. Our staff will lead campers through a variety of sports and sport related games which may include soccer, dodgeball, ultimate Frisbee, badminton and basketball. The emphasis is on recreation which allows participants to develop their skills at their own pace. Participants will learn the rules of the games, while developing a positive attitude towards physical fitness and healthy lifestyles. (Swimming and skating) **CSA approved hockey helmet required for skating.** *Free busing to and from camp is available.

Wide World of Sports Camp | Ages 7 to 12

Travel around world of sports in five days. A variety of worldly themed games and activities will allow participants to develop their athletic skills at their own pace while also developing a positive attitude towards physical fitness and healthy lifestyles. Participants will have the opportunity to swim and skate once during the week. **CSA approved hockey helmet required for skating.** *Free busing to and from camp is available.



Science & Technology

Cartoon Computer Animation Camp | Ages 6 to 11

Come unleash your imagination in this camp by creating your own animated cartoon movie. You will be guided step by step in a collaborative, computerized environment, as you create and watch your cartoon come to life. The software's engaging design and multiple levels, offer a fun and rewarding experience. At the end of the camp, parents will be sent their child's animated movies. Campers will be split into two groups where half the campers will spend three hours with the KGM team and the other half will be spent with the Camp staff. After lunch the groups will switch. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

CreationLab: Adventures in Interactive creationlab Programming | Ages 8 to 12

Get creative in a maker environment that blends arts, electronics and code. Experience the Makey Makey board; exploring beginner technological literacy, interactive games, musical instruments and amazing game controllers. Campers will code, draw, build, and colour, helping programming to be contextual and fun. Campers will be split into two groups where half the campers will spend three hours with the KGM team and the other half will be spent with the Camp staff. After lunch the groups will switch. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

Lego Camp™ | Ages 6 to 12

Lego challenges, art projects, games and activities. Ultimate build off competitions, team building and more. Join us for a fun, interactive and hands on Lego themed camp. Participants will have the opportunity to swim once during the week. ***Note:** please do not send your child with Lego. We cannot be responsible if it is lost, stolen or mixed in with ours. *Free busing to and from camp is available.

STEAM Camp | Ages 7 to 12

Finish off your summer with a week full of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics. Your child will have a great time learning, exploring, building, and creating with exciting S.T.E.A.M activities each day. Participants will have the opportunity to go swimming once during this session.

Super Charged Science Camp | Ages 6 to 12

A camp for the budding scientist in the house. Your child will have a terrific time learning science concepts in a fun and hands on atmosphere. Campers will create fun and easy science experiments every day. Participants will have the opportunity to swim once during the week. * Free busing to and from camp is available at the Diane Hamre Recreation Complex only.



Kinder Camp

Kinder Camp | Ages 4 to 5

Each week is packed full of games, arts, crafts, sports, and outdoor activities. The focus is on fun, but children are also developing social, sharing and co-operative skills while at camp. Each week is planned around a central theme and full of age appropriate activities. Just for Teens

Counsellor in Training (CIT) | Ages 14 to 16

The Counsellor in Training Program is a 1 week program designed to develop skills essential to working with children. During this fun, energy filled week, participants will learn how to lead activities and games, as well as develop problem solving and leadership skills in a camp setting. In order to receive their CIT Certificate, participants must complete a 1 week volunteer placement (eligible for community service hours) with Clarington Camps. Volunteer information packages will be distributed on Monday and placements will be assigned on Friday of the in-class portion of the program. Upon successful completion of the CIT program and placement, participants will receive a certificate.

Leaders in Training | Ages 12 to 14

The Leaders in Training (LIT) program is a one week camp designed to develop skills in being the leaders of tomorrow. The program is interactive and youth will participate in activities both inside and outside. This program is excellent for youth interested in learning the following skills:

- Motivation/goal setting
- Leadership
- Communication
- Conflict resolution
- Team building
- Volunteer work
- Career preparation
- Resume/Interview tips
- Role modeling

Upon successful completion of this program, participants will receive a Certificate of Completion. Participants will have the opportunity to swim once during the week.

Extended Care

Camp Busing

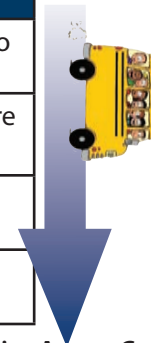

Bus Schedule

Arrive five minutes before the scheduled time and prepare to remain up to 10 minutes after the scheduled time.

During the morning route, campers will get on the bus at their bus stop and get off at the appropriate camp location. Staff are on the bus to make sure all campers go to the correct camp. During the afternoon route, campers get off the bus at their drop-off location pick-up. The bus only runs one way. Make sure you sign up for a bus stop that will take your camper on to their camp location.

Bus Rules
