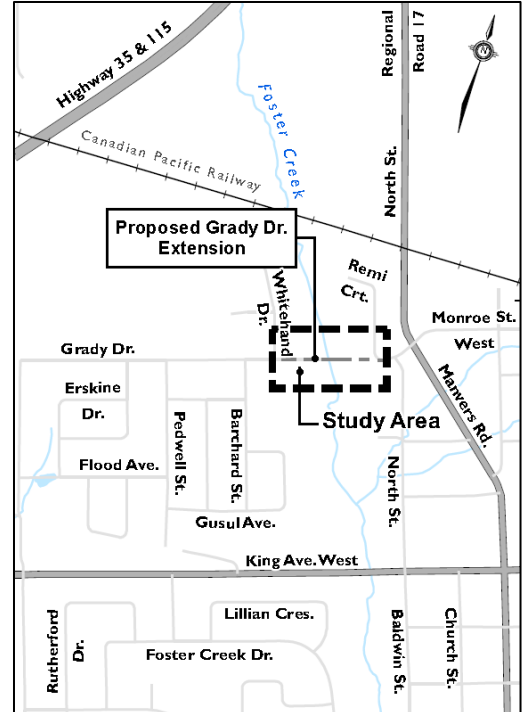
Schedule 'B' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Grady Drive Extension, Foster Creek Crossing, Newcastle

The Municipality of Clarington undertook a Schedule 'B' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to investigate alternatives for providing an improved transportation connection across Foster Creek, in accordance with the Municipal Engineers Association's Municipal Class EA document October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015.

The study area is shown on the map included here.

Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Municipality of Clarington intends to proceed with the construction of this project. Details on this process are provided in the Project File. Requests must be received by the Minister within 45 calendar days of this Notice.
