## Eligibility criteria:

- · Participants must be a resident of Clarington;
- Residents will be permitted to complete a maximum of one (1) tile per person;
- A limited number of tiles will be reserved to ensure tiles are distributed amongst different demographics. Must be able to drop completed art tile off to Diane Hamre Recreation Centre, Courtice Community Complex or Clarington Public Library - Bowmanville Branch prior to September 10, 2021 at 4 p.m.
- Participant acknowledges and agrees that the Municipality of Clarington will determine in its sole
  discretion whether a tile submitted will form a part of the mural. If a tile is selected for the mural,
  the participant acknowledges and agrees it may be replaced or removed at the Municipality's
  absolute discretion, with no obligation to return the tile to the Participant. The Participant
  acknowledges the Municipality's role as outlined below.

### Tile designs must not contain:

- Advertisement or promotion for any business, organization, product, or viewpoint including logos, wordmarks, or symbols;
- Vulgar, profane, offensive, negative, or insensitive images or writing;
- Any breach of intellectual property, trademarks, brands, or images of illegal activity;
- Any attachment of any object(s) to the tile.

### Tile designs are encouraged to:

- Be innovative in design, foster community pride, and contribute to a sense of identity for residents;
- Where possible, designs should fit the character of Clarington. Themes may include nature, local history, local attractions, interesting features and/or celebration of arts and culture. For inspiration, please review the list provided by Clarington Museums!

#### The Municipality's role:

- All designs will be subjected to Municipality of Clarington review and approval. The Municipality reserves the right to reject any submissions;
- The Municipality cannot guarantee the duration of exhibition of the tiles. Participants must accept the risk that their artwork may be damaged, altered, or removed at any time after completion;
- The Municipality of Clarington reserves the right to alter, edit, modify, adapt, reproduce and/or illustrate the artwork for any use, including promotional purposes.
