



Appropriate Swimming Attire - *Updated Policy*

The Community Services Department has undertaken a review of the existing swim suit/bathing attire policy. To ensure the inclusion of everyone wishing to use our pool facilities, we have revised our requirements, to be implemented immediately. We thank everyone in advance for their understanding and support.

All participants using the pool/whirlpool/sauna must change from street clothes to a swim suit and/or clean clothing brought to the facility for the purpose of swimming. Participants may choose to wear t-shirts, thin long sleeve shirts, shorts or tight fitting leggings. Clothing worn in the pool must permit individuals to participate safely in programs. Head covering must be tight fitting and ensure the safety of the participant.

Undergarments, cut-offs, jeans and loose clothing are not permitted in the pool. Shoes must be removed before entering the shower and pool area.

For swimmers who are not toilet-trained, specially designed swim diapers are required.

Patrons wearing street clothes are only permitted to watch from the pool viewing area.
