

Winter Safety tips from Clarington Emergency & Fire Services



Please check on your neighbours, especially the elderly, to make sure they don't need assistance shovelling snow or going to the grocery store.

We ask residents to please clear a path and all snow from fire hydrants located on their properties, this allows firefighters access in case of an emergency.

Keep driveways and walkways clear so firefighters can easily access your home.

Please check for snow buildup around your home to make sure the snow isn't covering your vents.

Please drive carefully, snow piles can often block sight lines on driveways and roads.

Please watch for children while driving, especially in subdivisions. Snow piles can make it difficult to see pedestrians and children.

In cold temperatures watch for areas of your home that are not heated well, watch to avoid freezing pipes or icicle buildup on eavestroughs.
