### **Ontario Fire Code:**

The Ontario Fire Code stipulates specific safety measures to be in place prior to and during a demolition. The owner/authorized agent of the owner shall insure that, where applicable, the demolition of the building is carried out in accordance with Section 8.1 of the Fire Code. #### **Environmental Considerations:**

It is the responsibility of the building owner/authorized agent to ensure the safety of workers from hazardous materials including, but not limited to asbestos and lead paint in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations. Furthermore, a detailed survey to determine the types and conditions of hazardous material shall be carried out and provided to the Contractor prior to demolition.
