 - 2024-049 Being a By-law to amend By-law 84-63, the Comprehensive Zoning By-law for the Corporation of the Municipality of Clarington
 - 2024-050 Being a by-law to confirm the proceedings of the Council of the Municipality of Clarington at this regular meeting held on October 28, 2024.
