Mayoral Decision MDE-2024-008

To give written notice for the approval of by-laws.

Under the Authority: Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 284.11 (Veto Powers for By-laws):

The Mayor has decided as follows:

1. The Mayor will not exercise the power to veto the following by-laws, passed at the October 28, 2024, Council meeting:
 - 2024-044 - Being a By-law to amend the Exotic Animal By-law 2012-045 that regulates prohibited animals in the Municipality of Clarington
 - 2024-045 - Being a by-law to close and to authorize the sale of part of a road allowance
 - 2024-046 - Being a By-law to establish, lay out and dedicate certain lands as public highways Clarington, to assume certain streets within Clarington as public highways in Clarington, and to name them
 - 2024-047 - Being a By-law to establish, lay out and dedicate certain lands as public highways Clarington, to assume certain streets within Clarington as public highways in Clarington, and to name them.
 - 2024-048 - Being a By-law to establish, lay out and dedicate certain lands as public highways Clarington, to assume certain streets within Clarington as public highways in Clarington, and to name them.
 - 2024-049 - Being a By-law to amend By-law 84-63, the Comprehensive Zoning By-law for the Corporation of the Municipality of Clarington
 - 2024-050 – Being a by-law to confirm the proceedings of the Council of the Municipality of Clarington at this regular meeting held on October 28, 2024.

2. This Mayoral Decision provides written notice to approve the above by-laws.
3. This Mayoral Decision comes into effect on October 28, 2024.
