A lower tax rate does not equal lower property tax.



Taxes paid per year*

Setting the tax levy

The cost of providing Municipal services is added up and divided by the total assessed value of properties in Clarington. The Municipal Property Assessment Corporation assesses all homes and properties across Ontario and determines what your home is worth. Generally, Clarington's assessment is lower than other municipalities, as we have lower property values, which means that proportionally our tax rate is higher. The cost of services is roughly the same and in Clarington you are getting more for your dollar as our Municipality is larger and our services extend further.
